#### Conditions of Approval:

**This authority is in force from 1/07/2017 to 30/06/2018.**

- G 1** The holder of this authority is required to comply with the 'General Standards for Exhibiting Animals in New South Wales'.
- G 2** The holder of an authority must cause the authority to be at all times publicly displayed in a prominent position on the authorised premises.
- G 3** If animals are exhibited in an enclosure, the enclosure must, as far as possible, provide a naturalistic setting that resembles the animals' habitat and provides for their behavioural and physical well-being as required by Clause 19(a) of the 'General Standards for Exhibiting Animals in New South Wales'.
- G 4** The authority holder is required to maintain a policy of insurance, providing cover of an amount approved by the Secretary, against any liability of the holder, or of a servant or agent of the holder, for death, injury or damage that arises out of or in connection with an activity authorised by the authority.

- S 1** The authority holder's exhibition of Indo-Pacific Bottle-nosed Dolphin (*Tursiops aduncus*) must comply with the requirements that apply to the exhibition of Bottle-nosed Dolphins (*Tursiops truncatus*) set out in the Standards for Exhibiting Bottle-nosed Dolphins (*Tursiops truncatus*) in New South Wales published in April 1994. Clause 2.4.4 d) iii) of those standards is varied in its application to the use of the Discovery Stadium Show Pool as a second primary dolphin pool for the exhibition of Indo-Pacific Bottle-nosed Dolphin (*Tursiops aduncus*) at Dolphin Marine Magic (licensed animal display establishment L00002) as follows:

The second primary pool shall meet the minimum dimension requirements outlined in clause in 2.4.4.(d) (ii) for the number of animals held, except that the pool shall not be narrower than 12 metres, nor shallower than 1.5 metres and the average depth of the pool shall be at least 1.8 metres. The second primary pool shall have a minimum volume of 477 cubic metres.
